Services to Veterans

- **The Department of Labor's Veterans' Employment and Training Service (VETS) sponsors a wide variety of employment programs for Veterans:**
 - **Grants to State Workforce Agencies**
 - **Grants to Community and Faith Based Organizations**
 - **Employment Workshops for Separating or Retiring Military Service Members**



Employer Access to Veterans - I

- **Employers' primary point of access to the Veterans served by VETS is through the Department of Labor's One-Stop Career Center System**
 - **Operates in all 50 States, the District of Columbia and three U.S. Territories**
 - **Includes over 3,000 service delivery locations nationwide**



Employer Access to Veterans - II

- **VETS funds two types of veterans' specialists at One-Stop Career Centers**
 - **Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) specialists primarily provide employment services to Veterans**
 - **Local Veterans' Employment Representative (LVER) staff conduct outreach to employers**

Employer Access to Veterans - IV

- **Electronic access to resumes for Veterans seeking employment**
 - All State Workforce Agencies sponsoring One-Stop Career Centers sponsor Web-based State Job Banks – access at Service Locator Web site
 - Many public, private non-profit and private profit-making organizations also sponsor Web-based points of employer-veteran interface
 - VETS is seeking some convergence among the many sponsors of these Web-based resources
