#### Governor Larry Hogan Announced Maryland Reaches 10,000 Registered Apprentices

Highest Participation Since 2008; Apprenticeships Provide Expanded Opportunities for Maryland Workers and Employers



Governor Larry Hogan and Labor Secretary Kelly M. Schulz today announced that Maryland has reached more than 10,000 registered apprentices currently earning and learning in the Maryland Apprenticeship and Training Program - the highest participation rate since 2008. ### President Trump signs FY 19 Labor-HHS Appropriations Bill



President Trump signed the FY 19 Labor-HHS bill, the first time this bill has been enacted before the end of the fiscal year on September 30<sup>th</sup>.

Five of the twelve appropriations bills have now been enacted. The bill contains the FY 19 defense appropriations bill and a continuing resolution to keep federal agencies yet to be funded open through December 7<sup>th</sup>.

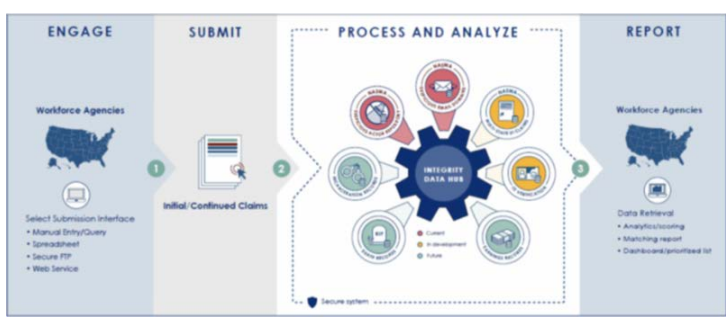
