

	through a single application. TCI Plus is free and was specifically developed to address
	the needs of Vocational Rehabilitation, but may be used for other workforce programs.
	TCI Plus offers information through The Career Index, including salary information, job
	trends and projections, current job openings, educational and experience require-
	ments (including licensing and certification), knowledge, skills, and abilities needed,
	and related training programs. In addition, TCI Plus offers tools designed to personalize
	career searches, including skills and interest inventories and fit analyses.

Solutions Offered	TCI Plus is designed to facilitate informed career decision making, by taking large amounts of data and combining it in a way that is both comprehensive and easy to use. TCI Plus includes all of the information offered through The Career Index, with addi- tional tools including an interest inventory; O*NET based skills analysis; career ladders and educational level selections; a benefits calculator; and a "fit" analysis that analyzes variables relating to career viability and suitability based on a user's profile.
Availability	I CI Plus is available to all states.
Organizational Governance Structure	TCI Plus was created in collaboration with WINTAC (Workforce Innovation Technical Assistance Center) through a grant from the Rehabilitation Services Agency. Partners in WINTAC include George Washington University, San Diego State University, University of Arkansas, Syracuse University, Council of State Administrators of Vocational Rehabil- itation, National Disability Institute, and Policy Works.
Scalability with other WIOA Programs	Scalable to other states/titles.
Pilot Projects	TCI Plus itself is one of the WINTAC's Workforce Innovation Pilot Projects (WIPP). Other WIPPs include SARA, an AI-based, mobile application designed to gather key perfor- mance and progress information, and Peer Mentoring, which includes the develop- ment and use of peer mentoring networks for young people with disabilities to facili- tate transition from secondary education to postsecondary education and employ- ment.
User Training Opportunities	Training is available for state agency staff through WINTAC TA for vocational rehabilita- tion and partners. Training videos and manuals are available for system users.
Connectivity/Integration with other WIOA Systems	TCI Plus is a standalone information delivery system of federal, state, and local labor market and occupational data. It was not built to integrate directly with other systems.
