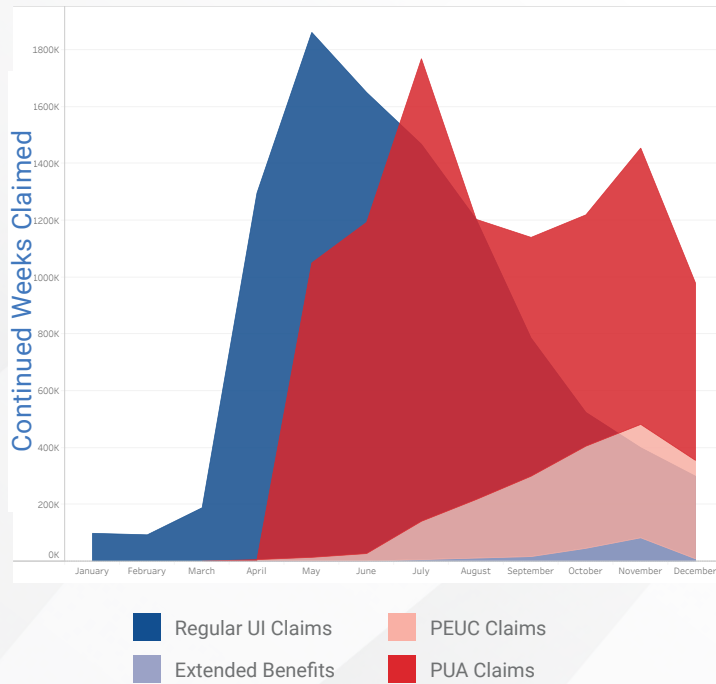

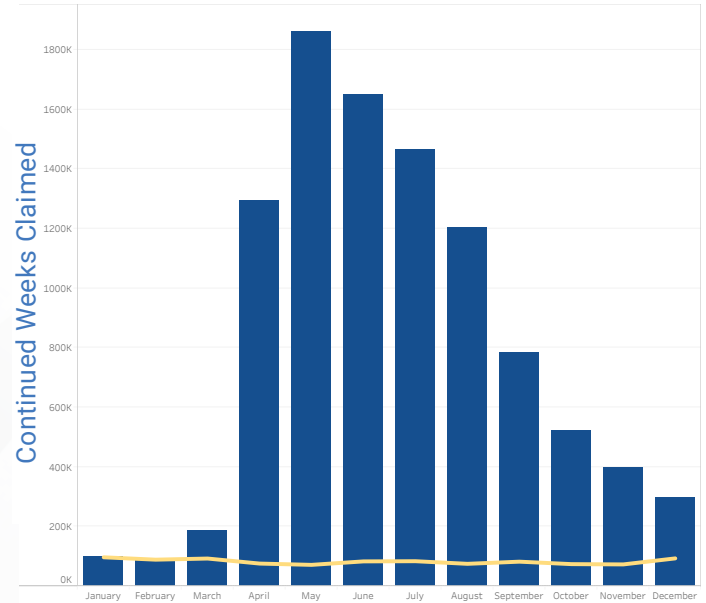
### TOTAL CLAIMS PROCESSED

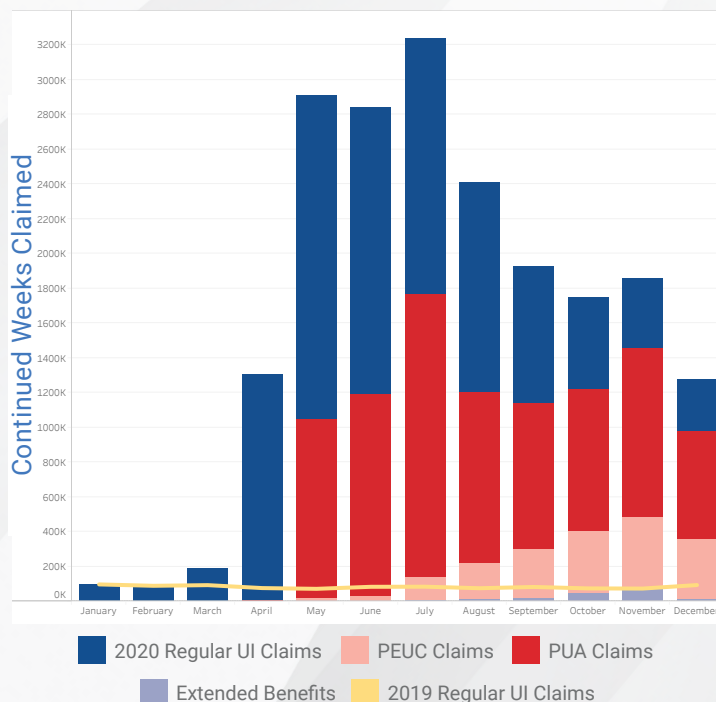

### REV GRANTS

#### REV Grants for Virginia Workers Impacted by COVID-19

Last fall, Virginia's Community Colleges received \$27M to help Virginians who lost their jobs due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The funds provide qualifying students free access to educational training for jobs that Virginia employers are eager to fill.

The deadline for Re-Employing Virginians (REV) Grants has now been extended through December 2021. These grants cover community college tuition for unemployed and underemployed Virginians who wish to train in one of the following fields: Early Childhood Education, Healthcare, Information Technology, Manufacturing, Public Safety, and Skilled Trades.



Training courses for individuals who are unemployed or underemployed due to COVID-19, offered by Virginia's Community Colleges with up to \$3,000 to cover tuition and fees.
