

UI State Information Data Exchange System (SIDES)

Promotes integrity in the UI program through the UI claims process by enabling states to communicate with employers securely, at no-cost. The founding principle of SIDES is a standard format that provides consistency between states, dynamic questions flows, and a reduction in the need for follow-up.

SIDES Exchanges

SEPARATION INFORMATION: Employers use an automated system to expedite sending separation information once a claim has been filed.

MONETARY & POTENTIAL CHARGING: States notify employers of wages used to set up claims and allow them to verify correct wages are utilized.

ADDITIONAL FACT-FINDING: States communicate with employers and thirdparty administrators (TPAs) to answer questions during a claim investigation.

DETERMINATIONS & DECISIONS: States notify employers and TPAs of non-monetary decisions and allow quick expediting of appeals.

EARNINGS VERIFICATION: Automates audits sent to employers.

BENEFIT CHARGES: State provides final charge notices electronically at the end of a billina cycle.

POWER OF ATTORNEY: TPAs electronically request, modify, or rescind access to employer accounts for benefits and/or tax.
